## TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF EDUCATIONAL TOUR

The following routes will be used for the Educational Tour, subject to final approval by the Principal and the College Picnic and Tour Committee in consultation with various stakeholders.

1. Udhampur-Delhi-Chennai-Kanyakumari-Trivendrum-Cochin-Goa and back. (16 Days/15 Nights)
2. Udhampur-Delhi-Ernakulam-Trivendrum-Kanyakumari-Goa and back. (15 Days/14 Nights)
3. Udhampur-Delhi-Hyderabad-Banglore-Goa and back. (15 Days/14 Nights)
4. Udhampur-Delhi-Banglore-Mysore-Ootey-Goa and back. (15 Days/14 Nights)
5. Udhampur-Delhi-Jaipur-Ajmer-Pushker-Jodhpur-Jaisalmer and back. (14 Days/13 Nights)
6. Udhampur-Amritsar-Jalandhar-Mcleodganj-Dharamshala-Palampur-Jawalaji- & Back. (6 Days/5 Nights)

The terms and conditions to be obeyed by the registered travel agents and tour operators are:

1. A travel agent will ensure the to and fro journey of the student, i.e., from Udhampur and back to Udhampur.
2. It has to be ensured that the train ticket reservation is done well in time and that too by sleeper class.
3. Stays in deluxe/three-star hotels should be managed on a three- or maximum four-share basis.
4. The buses for the tour should be semi-deluxe.
5. Safety and security will be the sole responsibility of the tour agent during the journey and in the hotels.
6. The entry fee/ticket charges/fee during the site seeing of monuments/parks/gardens/museums/aquariums shall be borne by the travel agent.
7. Full meals (breakfast, lunch, evening tea, and dinner) should be served at the proper times during the tour.
8. The travel agent must ensure the quality and hygiene of the food.
9. Payment of any sort shall be made through NEFT/CHEQUE (digital transaction) in three installments. The first installment of 20% will be paid in advance, the second installment on route, and the third installment will be paid after satisfactory feedback by students and escorting staff on return after the conduct of the tour at the college.
10. The tour agent is solely responsible for the character and credentials of the staff hired.
11. The services of a local tourist guide during site seeing must be ensured for the enrichment and acquaintance of students.
12. Alcohol consumption by <sup>or misconduct</sup> tour agents/members will result in a financial penalty.
13. In case the operator does not obey the guidelines, he/she shall directly bear the financial implications, which may go to the level of payment deductions.
